

Updated Shore Rules

Club will award points for all fish landed but all undersize returned alive.

Dates, times, venues can be changed by the Shore Organisers up to and including the day of comp and you must always check with them first.

Members and Guests must report to a Shore Organiser at venue and also comply with any boundaries and all relevant rules.

Junior can share the same rod rest with the adult who will be responsible for them and also keep check they do not cause problems to others.

No baited traces in the water before comp start time unless agreed.

Two rods can be used with a maximum of 3 hooks only at any one time Pennell rig will count as 1 hooks, Trebles count as 3 hooks.

All fishing with club can be assisted with casting, baiting up, unhooking, but you must always wind in fish yourself to qualify for any points.

Float fishing may be used but if it causes problems it can be stopped.

No Feathering – No Spinning

Beads - Anti Crab or Small Spoons are allowed.

NO fishing off groins in club comps.

Piers can be fished if on a club competition list, floats may be used

Spot checks can be made on any boxes, bags or tackle being used at any time by the Shore Organisers or nominated members on the day of comp.

Any complaint on day not settled must be put in writing within seven days or it will not be raised or accepted to deal with by the committee..

Committee decisions will be final and accepted by all fishing with club.

Club and Committee are not held responsible for losses or injuries to all fishing or attending club competitions or events held how so ever caused.

It is up to the members and their guests to check on. venues, times, dates, or cancelled comps and anything else to do with shore fishing not the Shore Organisers or nominated members and you take your fish to them to check.

Shore Organisers can nominate any fish on any comp date for a Golden Award and before the comp starts.1 golden fish per member per comp only with a value of 30 points awarded, this one must be a Size Fish Only to qualify .

Shore Competition sheets will be ready for members once accepted in club.

Updated Points System

Points Awarded. All undersize fish	<u>MUST GO BACK</u>	5 points each
All Size fish and Over including specimen		20 points each
A Nominated Golden Fish caught on that day		30 points only
Winner	Points on day an extra	10 points
Second place	Points on day an extra	6 points
Third place	Points on day an extra	4 points

This will also include any Junior members fishing in the comps

Members with equal winning points totals will receive the same points

All members fishing on the day of the competition will receive 5 points

If the competition has to be called off all the fish caught up to that point will count for the points and the top three will also have the First. Second. Third. place points awarded at the time of the competition ending, all those that have fished will have the 5 points for attending.

Fishing on after the competition has been stopped or coming to an end will be classed as freelance fishing and will receive no extra points.

The sweep will be paid out at the end of fishing to winners.

Remember your bait, warm clothing, lights, tackle, food, and wet gear,
